A Resolution to Rename the Arts & Science Academic Building in Honor of a Woman Who Contributed Meaningfully to the University of Missouri

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HERE GATHERED THAT:

WHEREAS, women at MU, both historically and currently, make significant contributions to the education, advancement, and diversity of the entire university population at the levels of faculty, staff, and student; and

WHEREAS, the vast majority of academic buildings on campus are either named in honor of men, or lack a namesake altogether; and

WHEREAS, the graduate and professional students of the University of Missouri, in fellowship with the Chancellor's Committee for the Status of Women, seek to honor women who have contributed meaningfully to the betterment of the entire university; be it

RESOLVED, by unanimous vote of the General Assembly here gathered that the Graduate Professional Council endorses the efforts of the Chancellor's Committee for the Status of Women to rename the Arts & Science academic building in honor of a woman who has contributed meaningfully to the University of Missouri; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the process of selecting an honoree shall be open and transparent, allowing for recommendations and commentary from all university affiliates, be they student, faculty, staff, or alumni.
