The Forum on Graduate Rights (FGR) and Coalition of Graduate Workers (CGW) has called for a graduate student walkout this week on Monday and Tuesday, Nov. 9-10, to "stand in solidarity against systemic inequality" with Concerned Student 1950.

This past week the Graduate Professional Council (GPC) General Assembly passed <u>Resolution</u> <u>1516-06</u>: A Resolution Expressing Solidarity with Social Justice Movements on Campus. Please read the resolution to become informed of recent incidents on campus.

The resolution states that "the Graduate Professional Council stands in solidarity with those Mizzou community members and student organizations who are fighting for the collective social justice movement."

The GPC Executive Board encourages all graduate and professional students to participate in protests, rallies, and other solidarity events organized by both Concerned Student 1950 and FGR/CGW.

We understand that this is very short notice so many departments have not had the opportunity to meet and issue a statement. GPC encourages graduate student employees to check with their advisor or teaching supervisor if their department has not issued a "no repercussions" statement.
