

A Resolution for Revising the Scoring Rubric of the Conference Presentation Travel Award

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HERE GATHERED THAT:

- **WHEREAS,** The application form for the Conference Presentation Travel Award (CPTA, formerly the GPC Travel Award) was migrated to OrgSync in Fall 2017 without any updates to the CPTA scoring rubric; and
- **WHEREAS,** Aspects of the existing CPTA rubric are thus not well suited to the current scoring process and other aspects are unintuitive; and
- WHEREAS, GPC has been charged with administering the Professional Development Travel Award (PDTA) for the first time in October 2018 and must establish a scoring rubric for the PDTA through the ratification of Resolution 1819-05; and
- **WHEREAS,** The scoring rubric for the CPTA should be consistent with the PDTA rubric, with both rubrics being intuitive for the Finance Committee's application scoring process; therefore be it
- **RESOLVED,** By majority vote of the General Assembly here gathered that the Graduate Professional Council does approve the scoring rubric in Appendix B (with the differences between the former CPTA rubric and the new rubric being visible in Appendix A); and be it further
- **RESOLVED,** The GPC Finance Committee will use this rubric when evaluating CPTA applications from the October 2018 cycle onward.
