

Resolution No. 1920-07 A Resolution Supporting an Online Process for Renewing Parking Passes

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HERE GATHERED THAT:

- **WHEREAS,** Parking on campus is regularly discussed among the graduate and professional student community, and especially so during meetings of the General Assembly of GPC; and
- **WHEREAS,** Graduate and professional students have different parking needs than undergraduate students at the University of Missouri; and
- WHEREAS, The availability of parking passes in the online marketplace varies greatly each year; and
- **WHEREAS,** No student is currently guaranteed a parking location, nor is there an efficient online process for renewing a pass for the same parking lot or structure year-over-year; and
- **WHEREAS,** Parking & Transportation Services has offered to make an efficient Qualtrics survey for all graduate and professional students with a parking pass to renew their pass for the next academic year, and this survey will be released in late April or early May 2020; and
- **WHEREAS,** This Qualtrics survey will be hosted on the Parking and Transportation Services website, and students will be informed of this survey via a coordinated email campaign from their office, the Graduate School, and GPC; and
- **WHEREAS,** This online renewal process will not change how students purchase a summer parking pass, as students will be able to purchase a summer parking pass via a web portal and the summer permit will be priced at the prevailing permit price of the lot or structure; and
- **WHEREAS,** This online renewal process is intended to streamline the parking pass purchasing experience for all graduate and professional students throughout their stay at the University of Missouri; and
- **WHEREAS,** Any student who does not wish to participate in the automatic renewal system for their parking pass may choose to not fill out the Qualtrics survey, and instead they may enter the online marketplace and purchase any available parking pass during the graduate and professional student priority purchase day; therefore be it
- **RESOLVED,** By majority vote of the General Assembly here gathered that the Graduate Professional Council does support the development and use of an efficient online renewal process for graduate and professional student parking as outlined above; and be it further
- **RESOLVED,** That the Graduate Professional Council requests that Parking & Transportation Services makes the process for renewing a parking pass as simple as possible; and be it further
- **RESOLVED,** That the Graduate Professional Council requests that any additional details about graduate and professional student parking passes not already specified in this document be shared with the Executive Board and the General Assembly; and be it further
- **RESOLVED,** That the General Assembly here gathered charges the GPC Executive Board with presenting a copy of this Resolution to the Director of Parking & Transportation Services, the Vice Provost for Student Affairs, and the Dean of the Graduate School.
