A Resolution for a GPC Research Award Scoring Guide

- WHEREAS, The Thirty-Seventh (2019-2020) General Assembly allocated \$8000 to establish the GPC Research Award (RA) for graduate and professional students; and
- **WHEREAS,** The purpose of the GPC Research Award is to provide support for graduate student research and creative/scholarly activity independent of the GPC Travel awards; and
- WHEREAS, The AY20 Director of Professional Development has modeled the research award scoring guide after the existing GPC Conference Presentation Travel Award (CPTA) scoring guide but gives more weight to applications from students who are at advanced stages of their program; and
- **WHEREAS,** the proposed scoring guide allows the GPC Professional Development Committee to score research award applications in a more intuitive and transparent scoring process; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED,** By majority vote of the General Assembly here gathered that the Graduate Professional Council does approve the scoring guide in Appendix A; and be it further
- **RESOLVED,** The GPC Professional Development Committee will use the scoring guide when evaluating research award applications from the Spring 2021 semester onward; and be it further
- **RESOLVED,** The "Application form" point allocation is 25, the point allocation for "Statement of Intent" is 50, and the point allocation for "Letter of Recommendation is 25 as stated in Appendix A.
