 - 1. Reintroduction of the PRO Act
 - a. Expand the definition of what an employee is (think grad students)
 - b. Strengthens the establishment of unions and ability to bargain with employers
 - c. Mizzou isn't taking a stance on whether it likes it or not
 - 2. House passes \$1.9 trillion COVID relief package
 - a. \$1,400 individuals (same amount for each dependent)
 - b. \$25 billion for assistance in covering rent payments
 - c. \$170 billion for K-12 and Higher Ed

 - iii. Related to course fee increases
 - iv. Grad school rates are different than undergrad rates, and professional schools (law, business, etc.) are also different
