Target Population. All currently enrolled graduate and professional program students.


Distribution. The 2024 GPSE survey was distributed to students through university email from October - November, 2024. Students were sent an initial invite and three reminders.

IRB: The project (IRB #2093963) was designated a Quality Improvement Project by MU IRB.


Response Options. Students were provided an "Prefer not to respond" option on most questions, which have been omitted from the dashboard. Open-ended questions have been omitted as well.

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

Q26 - In the last 12 months, did you ever eat less than you felt you should or choose less nutritious food options because you did not have enough money? n=183, 18.0%











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Definitions

Academic Career. Broad grouping by Graduate or Professional Programs:

- GRAD: includes all academic programs that fall under the purview of the Graduate School
- MEDS: includes professional program students enrolled in MD
- LAW: includes professional program students enrolled in the JD
- VETM: includes professional program students enrolled in the $\ensuremath{\mathsf{DVM}}$
- PROF (OT/PT): includes students enrolled in MOT, DOT, or DPT

Academic Unit. Colleges and schools are approved to offer degree programs or oversee degree or non-degree programs approved by the state Coordinating Board of Higher Education. Because the organization of these units varies across the campus, these entities are referred to as academic units, or AUs for short.

Academic Program. The academic organization to which a student applies, is admitted, and ultimately graduates. These will, in most cases, correspond to schools and colleges.

Degree Level. Broad grouping based on type of degree:

- POSTBAC: non-degree seeking post-baccalaureate
- CERTIFICATE: graduate certificate
- MASTERS: master's degrees (e.g., MA, MS, MEd, MPA, MBA, etc.)
- SPECIALIST: educational specialist degrees (i.e., EDSP)
- DOCTORAL: doctoral degrees (e.g., PhD, EdD, DNP)
- FIRST-PROF: professional program degrees (e.g., DVM, MD, JD, DPT, MOT)

Full-Time or Part-Time. Refers to academic load:

- Full-Time: enrolled in 9 credit hours or more or at least 2 dissertation hours if in in post-comp status.
- Part-Time: enrolled in less than 9 credit hours.

Sex. Limited to Male, Female, or Unknown based on administrative data.

URM Status. Broad race/ethnicity categories based on administrative data:

- URM Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander, American Indian or Alaska Native, or persons with multiple racial categories that include one or more of these.
- INTERNATIONAL Non-U.S. citizens and those with non-permanent resident status.
- Non-underrepresented Minority (Non-URM) White, Asian, or persons for whom race/ethnicity was unspecified at the time of admissions.

Broad Field Type. Taxonomy based on cipcodes for each academic plan, which was adapted from the Council of Graduate Schools for the purposes of the survey:

- STEM: biological and agriculture sciences, engineering, mathematics and computer sciences, and physical and earth sciences.
- Social and Behavioral Sciences: social sciences, behavioral sciences, public administration and services
- Arts and Humanities: performance arts and languages
- Other: business, education, health sciences and other fields

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
